Teacher: Pat Otto
Project: Painted shirt with playful frogs
Medium: Fabric Paint

This month we are doing the black shirt with green frogs that Pat Otto modeled at the April meeting. The shirt she used was from Walmart. It is a ladies shirt - George is the brand. They run small, she found the Xtra Large a little tight. The men's department also has a George shirt that looks very nice hemmed. You may do it on a T-shirt or apron, black or dark color.

Pat will supply the paint and jewels. Bring fabric brushes if you have them, otherwise a 4, 6, 8 flat or angle and a liner brush. Tape your shirt to a board or iron freezer paper to the inside of the shirt. You may also use contact paper. Transfer the design with white Saral or fabric transfer paper. 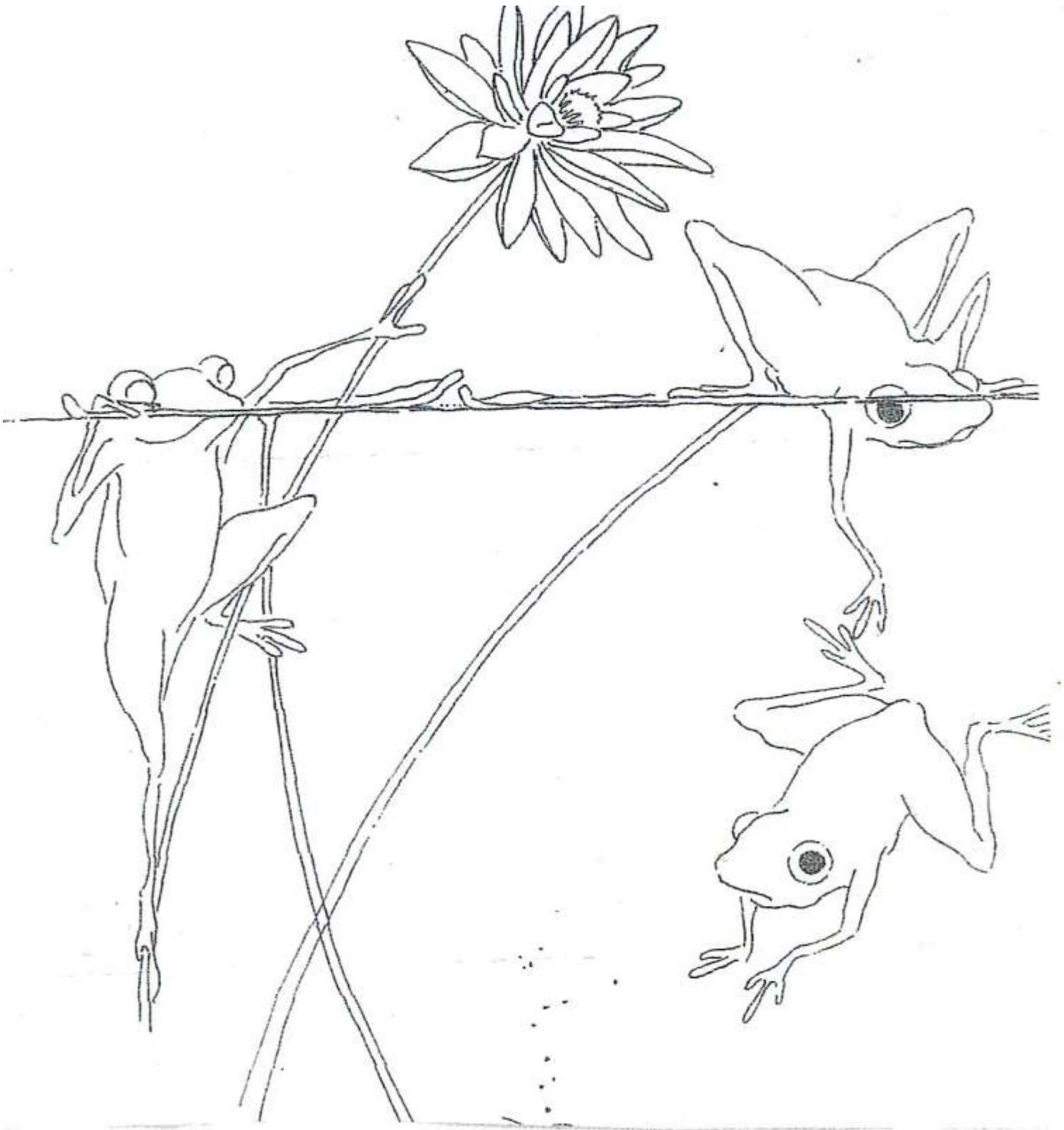
